Aquatic Complex Regulations 2022

The maximum capacity of swimmers in the recreational pool confines is 700 people.

Swimming is only permitted when lifeguards are on duty, from 6:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. on weekdays and 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays.

1. General rules:

- 1.1. Swimming is only permitted when there are lifeguards on duty.
- 1.2. Children under the age of 8 must at all times be within easy reach of a person aged 16 and over in the swimming area, based on the following ratios:
 - 1.2.1.: 0 to 24 months: 1 adult / 1 child
 - 1.2.2.: 25 months to 8 years: 1 adult / 3 children
- 1.3. Wear a swim suit, specifically a piece of clothing used solely for swimming purposes and which allows the person to swim freely (infants must wear a swim diaper).
- 1.4. Take a shower before going for a swim in one of the pools.
- 1.5. Follow the instructions of staff when a whistle sounds.
- 1.6. Comply with the chaperone regulations and the obligations required in monitoring young children.
- 1.7. Check the depth of the water and choose a section of the pool that is compatible with the swimmer's abilities.
- 1.8. Only use safety belts (dorsal ball or hippo belt) and personal flotation devices (PFDs) as a support for swimming.
- 1.9. Soiling the water in any way (urine, drinks, blowing your nose, etc.) is prohibited.
- 1.10. Diving into the water head-first, climbing on someone's shoulders and/or jostling another swimmer is prohibited.
- 1.11. The use of diving masks, flippers, tuba, inflatable games, balls and frisbees in the pools is not permitted.
- 1.12. Smoking and vaping are prohibited within a nine (9) metre radius of the Aquatic Complex. Moreover, the use of cannabis in this aforementioned radius or any other area subject to a ban is prohibited.
- 1.13. Using one's personal sound system to play music in the confines of the Aquatic Centre is not permitted.
- 1.14. Consumption of any type of alcoholic drink is prohibited.
- 1.15. Bringing glass containers is not permitted (plastic bottles are permitted).
- 1.16. Consuming food and drinks anywhere other than in the shaded area, located between the competition and recreational pool, is not allowed.
- 1.17. Bringing a pet, (including those on a leash), is prohibited.
- 1.18. Filming and taking photos in the dressing areas, on the pool promenade and the wading pool is not permitted.
- 1.19. Running is prohibited.



The aquatic facility officials have the authority and reserve the right to invoke disciplinary action and expel anyone who infringes one of the aforementioned regulations or who hinders activities, the safety of other swimmers or who displays a lack of respect, civility or politeness.

Access to the facility may also be denied to anyone showing impaired faculties.

IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY:

A long whistle sound indicates an emergency. If you hear this signal, all swimmers must stop what they are doing and follow the instructions. Lifeguards and the people in charge of the pool must automatically be informed about any accident or incident.
