1. Signing the contract\* is mandatory to confirm any reservation.
2. The client acknowledges that the payment deadline must be respected to confirm its reservation and that any payment made is non-refundable. Please note that, for our clientele outside the province of Québec, payment in full is required before each reservation.
3. The special groups and day camp rate applies for groups of a minimum 20 children, between the ages of 3 and 11. Children aged 2 and under do not have to pay.
4. Groups of fewer than 20 children or who are with people aged 14 and over can still make a reservation for an outing or camp. A specific rate will be posted for these groups.
5. Entry to the facilities is free for all chaperones. The minimum child/chaperone ratio must absolutely be respected:

<b>2 years and under</b>	<b>1 chaperone per 1 child</b> (personal flotation device must be worn at all times)
<b>Between 3 and 5 yrs</b>	<b>1 chaperone per 3 children</b> (personal flotation device must be worn at all times)
<b>Between 6 and 11 yrs</b>	<b>1 chaperone per 6 children</b>
<b>12 yrs and over</b>	<b>1 chaperone per 15 children</b>

6. The client agrees to having read and complying with the recommendations given in the “Guide for children’s group chaperones”, sent at the time of the reservation.
7. Each child must pass a swimming test conducted by a Société du parc Jean-Drapeau lifeguard before the child is allowed to go into the water area. If our lifeguard deems that a child lacks the ability to swim properly, the child must wear a personal flotation device (PFD).
8. Chaperones must go into the water with the children at all times. Chaperones must be at arm’s-length reach for children aged 5 and under and wear a swimsuit. Failure to comply with these rules may result in the expulsion of the group.
9. The client acknowledges and admits the SPJD is in no way responsible for any cancellation caused by bad weather conditions. However, it is possible to move your reservation without additional cost depending on the availability of our facilities. In the event of a cancellation, the SPJD will keep the \$40 deposit that was made at the time of the reservation. If the deposit has not been made, it will be charged.
10. The client acknowledges and admits the SPJD is in no way responsible for failure to fulfill its obligations, if such failure is due to a strike, picketing, riot, public disturbance, unforeseeable circumstances or superior force, or any act of a public authority, the breakage of a device serving the sites, or for any other reason beyond the immediate or direct control of the SPJD.
11. The client may not transfer, either directly or indirectly, its rights and obligations pertaining to the contract, in whole or in part, without prior written approval by the SPJD.
12. The client is responsible for proper use of the material and equipment and assumes responsibility for any breakage or any replacement that is required as a result of the misuse of said material or equipment.
13. The client uses the premises for the purposes stated herein and in compliance with the laws and regulations in effect at the Aquatic Complex and/or Jean-Doré Beach.
14. The client agrees to comply with the public health directives as well as the health measures and recommendations of the federation which sanctions its discipline as well as those put in place
15. Buses must pay the parking fees at the parking areas designated for this purpose (P7-P9-P10 for the Aquatic Complex and P4-P5 for the Beach).

\* The tax rates are subject to change from one year to the next and are provided strictly as a point of reference on the contract. An English-language version of the contract has been written to facilitate the reader’s understanding. In any case, the French-language version prevails.
