# SPORTS PLATFORMS

RENTAL  
TERMS



1. Signing of the contract is mandatory to confirm any reservation. No changes to the original contract will be permitted before the signing of said contract.
2. The client acknowledges the payment schedule must be respected to confirm the reservation and any payment made is non-refundable. Please note that full payment prior to any reservation in our facilities will be required from our clientele outside the province of Québec. The final invoice will only be payable at the end of the last training session.

\* The payment schedule may be changed at the discretion of Parc Jean-Drapeau

3. Any reservation request must be accompanied by a civil liability insurance policy providing, per event or accident, a minimum protection of TWO MILLION DOLLARS (2,000,000,00 \$) for bodily injuries and material damages, a list of every athlete taking part in the training sessions (it can be updated throughout the reservation period), and a copy of the accreditation certificates of each coach or support staffer (first aid for all, National Lifeguard for the Aquatic Complex and Beach). Parc Jean-Drapeau reserves the right to deny access if the documents are not provided.
4. The sports platforms are available solely for the rental period described in the "Space" section of the financial contract.
5. The renter must comply with the space assigned by Parc Jean-Drapeau's person in charge (example: Lane 2). Should other spaces become available, the renter must make a request to a person in charge at Parc Jean-Drapeau to use said spaces.
6. Any use of an additional sports platform or any exceeding of the reservation is automatically billed to the renter as an extra charge of the amount specified in the contract.
7. The renter is responsible for removing his/her equipment in relation to the following reservation, if needed. Parc Jean-Drapeau's staff will systematically inform the renter of such requirements prior to the said reservation.

- If the pool is free, the set-up can start 15 minutes before the designated reservation time, without charge.

- If the pool is occupied, we ask that the team/club using the pool finish its training session 10 minutes early, depending on the needs. At this time, we will provide a reduction equivalent to 10 unused minutes on the invoice, 16% of the last reserved hour. The rebate will also be applied to the team ending its reservation period, not to the team that gets there early to start setting up its platform.

In other words, if a swim team ends its training session and the next reservation is for a water-polo, diving or artistic swimming team, we require that the swim team take down the lane ropes 10 minutes before the end of the reservation to allow the team whose reservation is starting to set up the pool in relation to its needs and be able to start on time. A rebate equivalent to 16% of the last reserved hour will then be made on the invoice. Conversely, if a water-polo, diving or artistic swimming team ends its training session and the next reservation is a swim team reservation, we require the team that is in the water start the dismantling process 10 minutes before the end of the reservation and the swim team arrive earlier to set up the lane roping in relation to its needs.

8. Any moving of the reservations will incur an additional 15% in administration fees on the block of time that has been moved.
9. Complete cancellation of a reservation is charged at 50% of the planned rate unless we have received written notification of such at least three days in advance, otherwise the total amount of the fees is billed at the general public rate. A reservation in which no one shows up is deemed to be a cancellation unless a prior agreement was made with Parc Jean-Drapeau. In the event of lateness of more than 15 minutes, Parc Jean-Drapeau reserves the right to assign access to other users.
10. The client acknowledges and admits that Parc Jean-Drapeau is not responsible for any cancellation, whether partial or total, caused by bad weather. No refund will be forthcoming. In the event of a storm (lightning in the sky or claps of thunder) all basins must be evacuated for up to 30 minutes following the last sound of thunder or visual signs of the storm.
11. Access to the locker rooms is permitted 30 minutes before the rental period and only if the coach in charge of the group is present. For the Aquatic Complex, the locker rooms will be accessible only 15 minutes before the 6:30 a.m. reservation period, while the locker rooms will be accessible for only 15 minutes after the training session for reservations that end at 9 p.m.
12. Only the people whose names appear on the list of athletes/coaches are allowed access to the sports platforms. No parent, child of a coach and/or athlete is allowed.
13. The renter is responsible for the proper use of equipment and will be liable to Parc Jean-Drapeau for any damage arising from misuse.
14. The renter uses the premises for the specified purposes in compliance with the rules and regulations in force at the Aquatic Complex and/or Beach.
15. The renter promises to comply with the public health directives and the sanitary measures and recommendations of the federation sanctioning its discipline, as well as those implemented by Parc Jean-Drapeau.
16. The renter may not transfer, either directly or indirectly, its rights and obligations stemming from the contract, in whole or in part, without prior written permission by Parc Jean-Drapeau.
17. Upon expiration of the rental period, each rented sports platform must be left in the same state of cleanliness and proper storage as it was initially. In the event it is not, Parc Jean-Drapeau will bill the renter additional cleaning and handling fees in alignment with the damage.
18. In the event of an incident that occurs at the rented platform, Parc Jean-Drapeau may not be held responsible.
19. The renter acknowledges and admits that Parc Jean-Drapeau is in no way responsible for failure to fulfil its obligations if such failure is the result of a strike, picketing, a riot, a popular uprising, unforeseen circumstance or force majeure, or any other act of a public authority, equipment failure serving the two sites, or any other reason that would be beyond the immediate or direct control of Parc Jean-Drapeau.
20. The renter is responsible for returning all loaned equipment in their original state to the employee on duty. All damaged or unreturned equipment will be billed to the renter.
21. Please note the emergency number during your reservation is 514-872-9999 and the first-aid kits are located in the Infirmary of the Beach and the Infirmary of the Aquatic Complex.
22. The person in charge of the group is the custodian of his/her group and is charge of executing the appropriate measures outlined in the first-aid intervention plan set out by Parc Jean-Drapeau.

## TERMS SPECIFIC TO THE AQUATIC COMPLEX AND BEACH

23. In compliance with the Regulation respecting safety in public baths, the person in charge of the group that is on site must be at least 16 years of age and possess one of the following up-to-date certificates:

- National Lifeguard certificate issued by the Lifesaving Society for all reservations at the Aquatic Complex and/or for the open-water swimming area of the Beach;
- National beach lifeguard certificate issued by the Québec Lifesaving Society for all reservations in our beach areas.

24. The number of certified people in charge required during an activity depends on the number of participants (set in conjunction with the Regulation respecting safety in public baths) in accordance with the standards listed below:

Number of participants	Number of certified people in charge required
1 to 30	1
31 to 60	2
61 and over	3

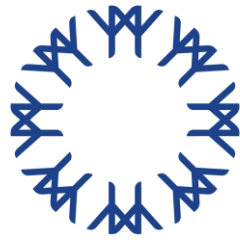
25. A swimmer or player certified as a lifeguard-monitor may not be regarded as such if he/she is training in the water

26. In the event where a person in charge does not have the required certification or where the number of people in charge is insufficient, Parc Jean-Drapeau can provide lifeguard-monitors at the rate in effect and at the cost of the renter, provided the request is made at least 14 days prior to the reservation date. The person in charge of the group is the custodian of his/her group and is in charge of executing the appropriate measures outlined in the first-aid intervention plan set out by Parc Jean-Drapeau.

27. Only the following aquatic equipment can be made available to you for the training session in the pools, on the condition the user is responsible for the total management of said equipment: turn flags and water-polo nets.

28. Dry land training is permitted on the pool decks, provided you mention this when making the reservation. Access to the pool will be granted 30 minutes before the appointed reservation time. Access may be refused if it wasn't asked for at the time of the reservation request.
