### **Guided tours (on reservation) and family snowshoe rally**

The popular guided tour on snowshoes to the Tour de Lévis is back again this year! In the evening, participants are equipped with a headlamp so they can see Montréal under a starry sky. Families can also participate in a rally on their own.
