**A diversified program**

The Fête des neiges de Montréal will be marking its 32<sup>nd</sup> anniversary this year and its program will be based around the outdoors, with a wide range of free activities and others that are at a modest cost. The activities include: tube sliding, a refrigerated skating path, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing, dog-sled and horse-drawn sleigh rides, a huge Ferris wheel with a great view of downtown Montréal, family Zip-line, ice sculptures, inflatable structures, shows and entertainment on the big stage, and a tiny tots' zone! Furthermore, this year, the Fête des neiges de Montréal will have new items in its on-site food offering.
